Eligibility requirements

- You must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada
- You must demonstrate a strong interest in cancer research and in pursuing graduate studies in the field of biomedical research
- You must be enrolled full-time at the deadline application date in an undergraduate program in a field related to life sciences or biomedical research
- You must have maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 out of 4.3 (70%, B, or the equivalent)
- You must never have received an IRIC Next Generation Award

Application package

Your application package must contain the following documents:

1. The application form, duly completed (iric.ca/en/awards)
2. A letter of intent describing:
 - your academic background and past research experiences
 - your interest in cancer research
 - your academic and professional goals
 - your vision of how this internship will benefit you on a personal, academic and professional level
 - the names of the investigators offering the three internship projects that you have selected and the reasons behind your selection
3. A transcript of your university-level academic record (scanned documents accepted)
4. Your résumé

Optional

A letter of recommendation from a professor or any other person who can attest to the quality of your academic record including, if applicable, any research experience you may have. This letter must be sent confidentially, by email, directly by your referee

Results

Applications will be evaluated by a selection committee made up of IRIC principal investigators. Results will be communicated to applicants in March, 2018
